

SEPTEMBER GARDENING CHECKLIST

FALL IS FOR GARDENING!

- ☐ Refresh containers with cool season color including Matrix® Pansies, Marigolds, Mums, Petunias and more
- ☐ Fill your flowerbeds with perennials for color that returns year after year
- ☐ Use Calloway's Premium Flowerbed Garden Soil and fertilize with Calloway's Premium Flower Food or Natural Lawn & Garden Food
- ☐ Late in the month divide spring flowering perennials such as Daylilies, Iris, and Shasta Daisies
- ☐ Add new Trees & Shrubs so they have time to get established before next summer
- ☐ Use Calloway's Premium Tree & Shrub Garden Soil and fertilize with Calloway's Premium Flowering Shrub Food or Tree & Shrub Food
- ☐ Add cool-season vegetables to your garden
- ☐ Sow wildflower seeds that require cool winter temps to sprout in spring
- ☐ Fill in your lawn with grass plugs to give the grass time to establish before winter
- ☐ For new lawns: Apply Calloway's Premium Lawn Food 21-5-10
- ☐ For existing lawns: Apply Calloway's Premium Lawn Food Phosphorus Free 21-0-0
- ☐ Use Bonide® Weed Beater Complete or Corn Gluten Granules to deter weeds from germinating
- ☐ Watch for fungal diseases in lawns and if necessary, treat with Bonide® Infuse Spray or Granules

- ☐ Plant Cyclamen, Dianthus, Matrix® Pansies, Ornamental Cabbage & Kale, Snapdragons & more
- ☐ Fill your flowerbeds with perennials for color that returns year after year

- ☐ Divide summer blooming perennials such as Daylilies, Coneflowers, Iris and Phlox

- ☐ Add cool-season vegetables to your garden

- ☐ Sow your Perennial Rye and Fescue for a green lawn all winter
- ☐ Watch for fungal diseases in lawns and if necessary, treat with Bonide® Infuse Spray or Granules
- ☐ Rake and remove leaves on your lawn
- ☐ Add pumpkins, gourds, straw bales and colorful Crotons for a festive fall display
